Length of Stay in Residential Treatment—Behavioral Health Info Notice 23-001, Page 13

Residential Treatment services can be provided in facilities of any size. The statewide goal for the average length of stay for residential treatment services provided by participating counties is 30 days. The goal for a statewide average length of stay for residential services of 30 days is not a quantitative treatment limitation or hard "cap" on individual stays; lengths of stay in residential treatment settings shall be determined by individualized clinical need. However, counties shall ensure that beneficiaries receiving residential treatment are transitioned to another level of care when clinically appropriate based on treatment progress. DMC-ODS Counties shall adhere to the length of stay monitoring requirements set forth by DHCS and length of stay performance measures established by DHCS and reported by the external quality review organization.

UNSHAME CALIFORNIA

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is launching a Substance Use Disorder Stigma Reduction Campaign in partnership with Shatterproof. The National Stigma Initiative is dedicated to changing attitudes about substance use and substance use disorder (SUD). DHCS plans to launch the UNSHAME California campaign in Spring 2023. This campaign is informed by local community leaders, is evidence-based and data-driven, and promotes antistigma messaging through stories of Californians impacted by SUD. Shatterproof launched its first addiction stigma reduction campaign in Pennsylvania in 2020, preliminary results showed that 49.5% of participants who viewed the campaign reported being open to having a person with OUD as their neighbor compared to 38.0% of those who did not view the campaign. https://lifeunitesus.com/ In addition to Pennsylvania's campaign, Shatterproof kicked off a statewide campaign in Kentucky in March 2022 and will be launching a statewide campaign in Georgia later this year. https://unshameky.org/ Stay tuned for more updates on this campaign.
