QUALITY MATTERS CORNER!

The Site Reviews Fiscal Year 2022/2023 are now officially underway.

We will be focusing heavily on Progress Note content and quality. According to the Behavioral Health Information Notice (BHIN) 22-019 Section 4 A-E and DHCS Certification Standards Section 8000 a-b; c 1-3; 4 A, B i-v C; d 1-4; e 1 A-G; 2 the progress notes for all providers shall include one or more of the following:

- Client’s progress towards one or more goals in the **problem list**.
- Client’s attitude towards change: (dimension 4 and is the client progressing through the stages of change? Document any change talk).
- New issues that affect the client’s **problem list**.
- Types of support or interventions provided by the program or other service providers.
- A plan for the upcoming session.

We will also be looking for minimum services requirements and documentation:

ASAM Level 1.0 requires up to 9 hours per week.

ASAM Level 2.1 requires a minimum of 9 up to 19 hours per week.

ASAM Level 3.1 requires 20 hours per week 5 of those hours must be clinical.

If a client is attending less than the required number of hours or more than required number of hours there must be clinical justification documented which may include a Progress Note describing conversations with the client, the Program Supervisor and or the LPHA to determine if the client is appropriate for a change in Level of Care or if the change in hours is temporary.
