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#### **QUALITY MATTERS!**

#### Releases of Information and CFR 42 Part2 Requirements.

During this period, multiple CFR 42 Part2 deficiencies were identified. Most commonly:

- 1) 22 CCR Section 51476(a); Intergovernmental Agreement PP Section 10 c ii; Alcohol and other Drugs Certification Standards Section G 2 D requires that there must be an ROI for an emergency contact. If the client refuses, it must be noted in the intake note.
- 2) 45 CFR Section 160 and section 164 A, E; 42 CFR: requires that the client signs a Release of Information for EACH interagency referral.

Unfortunately, there have been instances where counselors were communicating with organizations and individuals outside of their programs without a Release of Information.

Exceptions for communicating without a release are specific and limited. Sharing information without client consent, is illegal and can potentially result in consequences up to and including fines, loss of certification/licensure and jail time. If the client refuses to sign you cannot communicate. Releases of Information must be individualized. When unsure, please contact Marsha B

#### **Recovery Services Rollout**

Brief counseling, recovery monitoring, care coordination and crisis intervention are now available to beneficiaries before, during or after treatment, as a stand-alone service. AODS has began to deliver RSS through the regional Adult Mental Health Clinics in San Pablo, Concord and Pittsburg as well as at Recovery Residences and at other community sites!!! RSS are an important component of a beneficiary's recovery process. The goal in Contra Costa is to reduce lapses before and in between treatment through RSS and as an After Care Option.
