6.	Fire Chiefs' Report – Chief Terry Carey, Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (CCCFPD)
	On behalf of the Fire Executive Chiefs, Member Carey brought one item forward: the fire-based pods concluded at the end of
	May. Fire personnel will standby if future vaccine clinics are needed.

8.	EMCC Officer Nominating Committee
	Per the Bylaws, it is time to identify EMCC members who are willing to participate on the EMCC Officer Nominating
	Committee. Current officers cannot participate on the nominating committee, so other members are needed to volunteer to

serve. Chair King had asked at the March meeting for anyone interested in participating to contact him directly. Because of a

	low response, he asked members Carey and Pangelinan to participate as the nominating committee. Both members agreed. Staff Morris will work with the nominating committee.
9.	Quarterly Update on Alliance Ambulance Services – Chief Terry Carey, Contra Costa County Fire Protection District (CCCFPD) No Report
10.	 EMS Medical Director's Report – Marshall Bennett on behalf of Senai Kidane, MD, Contra Costa EMS Agency Medical Director The LEMSA is accepting public comment until June 18 on proposed changes for Field Treatment Guidelines for 2022. After conclusion of the public comment period, the LEMSA will begin development of 4th quarter training that will accompany the changes. Dr. Kidane continues to be heavily involved in the County's efforts to develop a comprehensive model for responding to behavioral health crises. The trial looking at prehospital administration of Buprenorphine for opiate withdrawal continues. 16 patients have been enrolled so far. Other counties are reaching out and showing interest in the trial.
11.	EMS Director's Report – Marshall Bennett, Contra Costa EMS Agency Director - Director Bennett reported the LEMSA has completed the first round of outreach regarding the new ambulance ordinance. The LEMSA will continue to seek stakeholder feedback as that is integral to the process. The parties that have already been met with have identified some areas where changes will be beneficial. The next step is to include the EMCC on the updated draft, and then to extend outreach to other fire and first responder agencies. A special meeting may be called to go over proposed changes in the updated draft prior to the next regularly scheduled meeting in September.
