CCHP P&T Committee approved the following modifications to the formulary:	
Medication Name & Dosage Strength	Approved Formulary Changes
Human papillomavirus vaccine (Gardasil, Gardasil 9)	Age limit broadened to 19-45 years old
J7321 Supartz, Hyalgan	Added to “no auth list” and no longer requires a prior authorization
Oxycodone IR 5mg tablets	Added to tier 2 with quantity limit of 10 tablets per 5 days
Generic albuterol HFA (ProAir, Proventil, and Ventolin) inhaler	Added to formulary with no restrictions
Brand Name Ventolin HFA inhaler	Removed from the formulary, no longer preferred product
Generic Insulin Lispro (Humalog)	Insulin lispro 100 units/ml now formulary product, Apidra (insulin glulisine) to be removed from formulary.
Epipen	Quantity limit increased to #4 pens per 180 days
Symjepi (epinephrine) syringe	Added to formulary with equivalent status (Tier 2, Quantity limit) as Epipens
Colchicine 0.6mg tablets	Quantity limit increase to #15 tabs per 30 days
Granisetron (Kytril) Tablet	Added to formulary with step therapy, requiring ondansetron
Moxifloxacin (Vigamox) eye drops	Added to formulary, Tier 1
Valganciclovir (Valcyte) tablet	Added to formulary, Tier 1
Flonase Sensimist (Fluticasone) Nasal Suspension	Added to formulary, Tier 1
Budesonide (Rhinocort) Nasal Suspension	Added to formulary, Tier 1
Flunisolide Nasal Solution	Removed from formulary
Lanthanum (Fosrenol) chewable tablets	Change from Tier 2 to Tier 3; requires use of calcium acetate and Renvela
Alosetron (Lotronex) tablets	Removed from formulary to unlisted non-formulary
