17:38 CCHS-HMP received a Sheriff Dispatch page.

17:41 I. Williams of CCHS-HMP contacted Sheriff Dispatch by phone. EBRPD was requesting a phone call from CCHS-HMP. Staff at the Castle Rock Regional Recreation Area at 1700 Castle Rock Road in Walnut Creek had discovered approximately 14 piles of an unknown white powder under trees within the park grounds. Police and CCCFPD already on scene.

17:48 CCHS-HMP received CCCFPD Dispatch Page. I. Williams contacted CCCFPD by phone and spoke with BC Platt on scene. CCHS-HMP was requested to assist in identification and mitigation of the unknown white powder. A previous white powder incident at this same location on 12/6/21 was discussed at this time (IR# 211206-01).

17:50 I. Williams paged to activate the IR Response Team. A. Ackerman and F. Zappelli to respond with I. Williams in HM1.

18:10 I. Williams prepped truck for response.

18:33 HM1 departed office for scene.

18:58 HM1 arrived at 1700 Castle Rock Road in Walnut Creek.

19:05 I. Williams met with Captain Rabara. CCCFPD personnel had field tested samples of the piled white powder. The powder had tested out as corn or wheat flour. The team was able to find a flour bag in a nearby trash bin labeled "Sooji Ble Farina". Neutral pH. This result matches the prior incident in the park where it was determined that the white powder piles were a corn starch or flour of neutral pH.

19:10 CCCFPD and CCHS-HMP discussed with EBRPD options for clean up and disposal.

19:25 HM1 departed scene for the office.

20:15 HM1 arrived at truck bay. Equipment unloaded.
