**REPORT:**

7/15/21  
15:40 Contra Costa County Public Works contacted CCHS-HMP by phone. An abandonment of a poly spill kit container, possibly 15-gallons in size was discovered containing an unknown liquid. The liquid was believed to be gasoline.  
15:50 I. Williams of CCHS-HMP contacted CCCFPD Dispatch and asked to speak to Station 87. CCCFPD agreed to respond to scene and identify the unknown liquid. CCCFPD requested CCHS-HMP respond to assist.  
15:56 I. Williams paged/activated the response team.  
16:00 I. Williams and D. Lewis to respond in HM3. Team gathered equipment.  
16:11 HM3 departed office for scene.  
16:40 HM3 arrived on scene and met with Cpt. Hummel of Station 87. CCCFPD had already made entry and collected a sample of the unknown liquid. Field testing had identified the liquid as Kerosene, approximately 10 gallons in volume. Safely overpacking the container was discussed.  
16:45 I. Williams and D. Lewis overpack the poly spill kit container into a 55-gallon steel drum. Drum was loaded into HM3 for transport.  
16:56 Bill of Lading for the waste kerosene was completed.  
16:58 HM3 departed scene for office.  
17:29 HM3 arrived at office.  
17:30-18:00 CCHS-HMP unloaded drum into hazardous waste storage yard and rehabilitated HM3.
