**REPORT:**

At 11:30 AM, San Ramon Valley Fire Protection District (SRVFPD) requested Contra Costa Health Services Hazardous Materials Programs (CCHSHMP) to respond and mitigate a fentanyl spill on a police vehicle on the parking lot of the San Ramon Police Department (SRPD).

At 11:53 AM, HM1 (JP & AS) and NU in a Hazmat SUV enroute to scene.

At 12:13 PM, HM1 on scene. CCHSHMP met BC Mike Mohun and Engineer Chris Eberle from SRVFPD and Officer Halog from SRPD to discuss incident safety, objectives and goals. CCHSHMP would assist SRVFPD with the fentanyl mitigation.

At 12:17 PM, HM3 (IW, DL & XB) enroute to scene.

At 12:45 PM, HM3 and NU were on scene.

At 1:17 PM, safety briefing was conducted.

At 1:27 PM, safety briefing was completed. Hazmat Group positions were assigned. See Site Safety and Control Plan (ICS 208 HM), ICS201, ICS203 and incident briefing notes for more information.

At 1:30 PM, entry team (IW, Josh and Aaron) was on air.

At 1:31 PM, entry team made an entry and conducted reconnaissance of the vehicle.

At 1:33 PM, entry team placed the fentanyl plastic bag into double plastic bags. Entry team sprayed Dahlgren solution on items on top of the contaminated police vehicle's trunk, the trunk, and outside of evidence plastic double bags containing fentanyl. It took about 15 minutes for Dahlgren solution to deactivate fentanyl.

At 1:51 PM, entry team cleaned up the items and evidence plastic bags. Entry team placed cleaned items into a clean plastic bag.

At 1:57 PM, entry team exited the hot zone.

At 1:59 PM, entry team was off air.

SRVFPD rinsed the outside of the car trunk with firefighting water.

At 2:13 PM, post incident briefing was conducted.

At 2:37 PM, HM1, HM3, and NU departed from scene.
