08:54 Contra Costa County Fire Protection District Dispatch contacted I. Williams of CCHS-HMP by phone. CCHS-HMP was requested to respond to a leaking diesel fuel tank on Vasco Rd. in Brentwood by CHP and East Contra Costa Fire Protection District. Dispatch gave the contact phone number for FC Ruddick of Engine 52 to CCHS-HMP.  
08:57 I. Williams of CCHS-HMP contacted RC Ruddick of ECCFPD by phone. A vehicle accident resulted in the leaking of a damaged saddle tank on a semi-truck on Vasco Road East of Walnut Blvd. in Brentwood, CA. The saddle tank was believed to hold approximately 140 gallons at the time of the incident. The saddle tank was currently leaking with an unknown amount already on the road. ECCFPD had erected an earthen dike to prevent the fuel from reaching a nearby storm drain. Vasco Road had been closed between Camino Diablo Rd. and Walnut Blvd.  
09:02 CCHS-HMP Incident Response Team activated/paged. S. Heller and A. Springer to respond directly to the scene. I. Williams and N. Umemoto to respond in truck HM3.  
09:18 S. Heller arrived on scene and met with CHP and ECCFPD.  
10:03 HM3 departed office for scene.  
10:05 A. Springer arrived on scene.  
10:33 HM3 arrived on scene. I. Williams met with CHP and ECCFPD. The following incident information was provided:  
Driver of the vehicle: Kamar Wright, LA License 008265136  
Vehicle description: CA license plate XP47870, trailer CA license plate 4PV2182  
Owner of the vehicle: Cal Eagle Transport, 4709 N El Capitan Avenue, Suite 205, Fresno, CA 93722  
10:40 Safety meeting held.  
10:45 - 11:35 CCHS-HMP used a pneumatic pump and air cart to offload the remaining fuel within the diesel saddle tank into two 55-gallon steel drums after bonding the drums to the tank. The team then pumped the pooled diesel fuel off the road and into one 30-gallon steel drum. The team then spread granular absorbent over the spill area, and brushed the fuel into the absorbent with brooms and shovels. The diesel contaminated debris, including the earthen dike material, were collected into one 55-gallon steel drum and two 5-gallon poly containers. CHP to contact Public Works about possible further street sweeping of the affected area.  
11:35 All waste containers were properly labeled and loaded onto HM3 for transport to the CCHS-HMP hazardous waste storage yard.  
11:45 Bill of lading completed.  
11:49 HM3 departed scene for office.  
12:16 HM3 arrived at office.  
12:16 - 13:00 Hazardous waste containers were offloaded into the hazardous waste storage yard. Decontamination of pump equipment and rehabilitation of HM3 was performed.
