TANKER TRUCK CONTAINING 4,312 GALLONS OF SODIUM BISULFATE HAD A CAP LOOSE AND SPILLED APPROXIMATELY 50 GALLONS FROM HILLTOP TO LAKESIDE ON RICHMOND PKWY. SPILL IS CONTAINED AND NONE REACHED THE STORM DRAINS.

08:10 Captain Ron Davis of the Richmond Fire Department contacted Ian Williams of CCHS-HMP through the emergency response phone line. A tanker truck with a capacity of approximately 4300 gallons had spilled an unknown amount of Sodium Bisulfite (liquid) from a loose cap onto the Richmond Parkway Eastbound between Hilltop Drive and Lakeside Drive. The driver noticed the release and pulled over and had blocked a nearby storm drain with absorbent. The road had been closed down, and a contractor was en route to perform cleanup.

08:14 Ian Williams activated the Incident Response Team.

08:30 Ian Williams and Karine Abramians departed the office in HM3.

08:58 HM3 arrived on scene. CCHS-HMP spoke to Captain Ron Davis. The Richmond Fire Department had isolated the scene, and the spilled material was a 25% Sodium Bisulfite solution, with the spilled areas showing a pH of approximately 5.0 to 6.0. The spill did not reach any storm drains. Captain Davis provided CCHS-HMP with the following information:

The vehicle had departed the Chevron Richmond Refinery, with the destination being the Rodeo Sewage Treatment Plant. The spill occurred from an unsecured dome cap.

08:50 Ian Williams spoke to Jose Colin of Ponder Environmental Services. A cleanup plan was discussed.

The street was to be pressure washed and all fluids vacuumed up, keeping the material out of the storm drains.

09:10 CCHS-HMP observed the initial stages of the road cleanup performed by Ponder Environmental Services.

09:45 CCHS-HMP departed the scene in HM3.

10:30 HM3 arrived at office.

10:45 Truck rehab completed.
