19:30 Specialist 1214 spoke with Sheriffs Dispatch and Cameron Hawkins of CalOES. A concerned resident in Danville reported seeing a gray substance in a creek in Danville, CA.

19:35 Specialist 1214 phoned the reporting resident and discussed how to locate the observed chemical.

19:46 Specialist 1214 departed personal residence to investigate the reported spill in Danville.

20:02 Specialist 1214 arrived on Greenbrook Court in Danville and walked to the Iron Horse Trail. Inspector observed the confluence of two creeks at the trail, and walked downstream on the creek between the trail and North of El Capitan Drive - for approximately one mile. CCHS-HMP was unable to locate any discernible substances in the swiftly moving creek.

20:55 Specialist 1214 updated the Incident Response Team by text and returned to their vehicle.

21:17 Specialist 1214 notified Cal OES of updates to Spill Report 19-3365.

21:20 Specialist 1214 notified SRV Dispatch by phone of findings.

21:28 CCHS-HMP departed the scene.
