11:39 Spoke w/ Mike @ Dow and Brent Johnson. Everything has been shut down related to the release. The cell room has been closed. Employees who were being evaluated have taken showers as a precaution and have been released with no injuries.

11:53 Call Con Fire Dispatch Emergency Line. No pick up. Call Con Fire Dipatch office number. Let them know about the release and that we are sending inspectors out there in a rig.

11:56 Put out page for response.

12:00pm 1205(DWL), 1213(NU) responding w/ HM1 (6824)

12:28 HM1 on scene. Inspectors report that facility under reported release, there was a 3000-6000gal release, and release was reported as the hazardous component of the full release without being clear about units. There had been spray onto a roof which resulted into the release onto the asphalt.

13:45 HM1 departed from scene

15:28pm 72 hour report requested.
