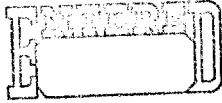

1538 John Pham of CCHS-HMP received a call from the reporting party. There is a red container believed to contain hazardous materials in front of the reporting partys' residence.

1630 John Pham and Ian Williams of CCHS-HMP equipped Truck HM3.

1700 John Pham and Ian Williams departed office in HM3.

1730 HM3 arrived at location of abandonment.

1745 Container identified as a red-poly 2 gallon fuel container. The container found on its side, mostly full- cap closed tight. ZContainer was carefully opened. Field identified as gasoline.

1750 The container was packaged for transport back to base.

1800 HM3 departed scene for office.

1830 HM3 arrived at base. Container placed in fire shed.
