10:31 - Received page from Comm-1. ConFire's "Captain Ben" is requesting we contact him. He is in Antioch with a leaking container.

10:33 - HMS Devra Lewis put IR Team on standby and then called Captain Ben Sanders. There is a dirty looking liquid in a 5 gallon plastic Alhambra water container. It has a gas-like odor. The bottle is leaking. They have contained the leak. They are requesting our assistance.

10:36 - IR Team activated to respond. HMS Daniel Vazquez is dispatched in POV directly to the scene. HMS Karine Abramians, Seth Heller, and Lewis are meeting at office to gather equipment and supplies for response.

10:47 - HMS Lewis contacts ConFire Dispatch to provide ETA for HMS Vazquez to arrive on scene as requested by Cpt Sanders.

11:04 - HMS Abramians at office loading equipment in HM3.

11:12 - HMS Pham and Lewis arrive at office. Equipment loaded into HM1.

11:16 - HMS Abramians and Lewis depart for scene in HM3. ConFire dispatch notified via radio.

11:19 - HMS Vazquez is on scene - releases ConFire.

11:26 - HMS Heller and Pham depart for scene in HM1.

11:36 - HM3 on scene. Area is assessed. A safety meeting is conducted. Contents of container are flammable. Contents in plastic water container are transferred to a 5-gallon DOT approved bucket. The absorbent put down by ConFire is swept up and bagged along with the empty 5-gallon plastic water jug container.

11:52 - HM1 on scene. The DOT approved 5-gallon container is labeled with a hazardous waste label and a bill of lading is completed.

12:02 - CCHSHMP departs scene after notifying apartment complex management.
