3/17/2016

1026 CCHSHMP contacted the Richmond Fire Department (RFD) dispatch and referred the incident to the Richmond Fire Department Hazmat team. RFD dispatch stated that they will send the Hazmat team to investigate the problem.

3/18/2016

1525 Ian Williams of CCHS-HMP received a phone call from EBRPD. The 5-gallon container had not been picked up due to a miscommunication between agencies.

1535 Ian Williams prepped Truck HM4 at office, coordinated with Sara Dwight of CCHS-HMP to meet at scene of abandonment.
