**REPORT:**

0942 HRS CONTRA COSTA HEALTH SERVICES HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PROGRAMS (CCHS-HMP) HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SPECIALIST (HMS) DEMPSEY RECEIVED A CALL FROM EAST CONTRA COSTA COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT REPORTING AN OVERTURNED PESTICIDE TRUCK. THE PESTICIDES FROM THE TRUCK MAY BE LEAKING.

0959 HRS HM1 REROUTE TO SCENE

1007 HRS HMS TOUGERON CONTACTED BATTALION CHIEF MATUMBER. CHIEF MATUMBER STATED THAT THERE ARE NO VISIBLE LEAKS COMING FROM THE PESTICIDE TRUCK, HOWEVER A DISTINCT PESTICIDE ODOR WAS OBSERVED. CHIEF MATUMBER STATED THAT AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS WERE LEAKING FROM THE VEHICLE COLLISION AND HAVE IMPACTED A DRAINAGE DITCH CONTAINING WATER. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT CONSTRUCTED AN EARTHEN DAM TO CAPTURE/CONTAIN THE AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS. CHIEF MATUMBER PROVIDED A LIST OF PESTICIDES REPORTED TO BE ON THE TRUCK AND ALL PESTICIDE CONTAINERS WERE STATED TO BE UNDER ONE GALLON IN SIZE (TALSTAR / WISDOM GRANULAR / ARCHER / GENTRAL / 2210L AEROSOL).

1020 HRS HM1 ARRIVED AT SCENE

1024 HRS HMS HELLER CONDUCTED AIR MONITORING (QRAE, MX-6). NO READINGS ABOVE BACKGROUND DETECTED. PH TEST STRIPS INDICATED THAT THE WATER IN THE DITCH WAS PH 4 DOWNSTREAM AND PH 6-7 UPSTREAM OF THE INCIDENT.

1029 HRS HMS TOUGERON OBTAINED A LIST OF PESTICIDES FROM THE BUG ZAPPERS TRUCK DRIVER STEVE COOPER AND COMPANY VICE PRESIDENT JODY ANDERSON.

ACCENTRIAL

1035 ENTRY WAS MADE BY HMS LEWIS AND HMS HELLER. OIL ABSORBENT PADS WERE PLACED IN DITCH TO CONTAIN AUTOMOTIVE FLUID SPILL. THE TOOL BOX CONTAINING PESTICIDES WAS OPENED. NO LIQUIDS WERE OBSERVED TO BE LEAKING FROM PESTICIDE CONTAINERS INSIDE TOOL BOX. ONE 5 POUND PLASTIC BAG OF WISDOM GRANULES OBSERVED TO BE OPEN AND SPILLED INTO THE TOOL BOX. NO VISIBLE EVIDENCE OF SPILLED PESTICIDES OUTSIDE OF THE TOOL BOX OR ON THE GROUND.

1120 HRS HMS LEWIS, HMS HELLER, HMS PHAM, AND HMS DWIGHT PLACED ADDITIONAL OIL ABSORBENT PADS INTO DITCH, RECOVERED USED OIL ABSORBENT PADS, CONTAINERIZED USED OIL ABSORBENT PADS, AND LOADED WASTE CONTAINERS INTO HM4 FOR PROPER TRANSPORT AND DISPOSAL.
