18:35 Sheriff's Dispatch Page - Notification Only - Boat crashed at the Discovery Bay Marina at the Fuel Dispenser - E Con Fire.

18:42 Call Con Fire to check Notification - Con Fire Requests Response, gives contact info for BC Brian Helmick

18:57 7777's put on pager to organize response.

19:03 AA calls BC Helmick to assess situation. Information is limited. Gas odors are strong, sheen and possible layer of fuel on water and plume may be expanding.

19:12 ED dispatched to scene

19:21 AA calls Cal OES to ensure Spill Report has been filed. Spill report filed, but doesn't mention dispenser.

19:27 AA Calls BC Helmick. Marine Patrol and facility have put out boom and absorbent pads. They would feel more comfortable with additional booms and pads. Estimated possibly 10 gal from boat and possibly 10 from dispenser.

19:39 SH at office loading rigs

19:50 ED on scene. Strong Fuel odors, sheen w/ possible fuel layer on top. Booms deployed, scuba diver helping harbor personnel begin process to recover sunken boat.

19:58 SD&AA arrive at office finish loading rigs

20:04 6868 En Route w/ SH & XB

20:19 ED sends photos of water and affected dispenser. (See attached Photo Log)

~20:20 ED determines that there is no active leak or flammable hazard and E Con Fire is released. Mechanical and Electric Shutoffs have been utilized to eliminate possibility of additional release.

20:25 6131 en route w/ AA & SD

20:26 ED reports Marine Patrol acquiring boat for water assistance (Marine boat not acquired).

20:28 ED sends additional photos of water and affected dispenser. (See attached Photo Log).

20:49 6868 on Scene w/ SH & XB

~20:55 CCHSHMP begins removing/recovering absorbent pads that have floated out of the boomed area.

21:15 6131 on scene

~21:25 Sunken Boat being lifted out of water, leaking/sheen is visible occurring from this process. CCHSHMP booms boat recovery area to prevent further contamination and utilizes some of the absorbent pads from the facility.

21:56 Departing Scene

8/1/2016 approx 9:10am: ED speaks with Jamal Acito via phone. Facility has removed most of the absorbent and has it in bags in the Marina Shed. CCHSHMP directs facility to obtain a temporary EPA ID Number for the absorbent waste and talk with Household Hazardous Waste, but that the marina shed cannot be the haz waste storage area. Hard boom will be removed today. A crew will check the dispenser and piping is okay either today or tomorrow. CCHSHMP instructs that boom should be cleaned.

8/2/2016: DL visits facility regarding Marina sheds. Cleanup is complete, Temporary EPA ID number has been obtained. Facility will work with Public works to replace the absorbent pads used during incident. (Pads used were for replenishing the shed.) Dispensers and piping is new and never had fuel in it.
