REPORT:

8/14/16:

CCC Sheriff calling to report used oil abandoned and spilled on public road in Brentwood. DV, MD, SD, TA responding for a clean up operation.

HMS on scene with 6868 and flat bed.

Prior to the start of clean up operations, 208 site safety plan is written, PPE is donned and work mission duration established. Traffic cones used to block off traffic at oil spill. HMS used absorbent to scrub and clean up oil on street. Used absorbent is collected in 55 gallon drum, used oil is bulked in 5 gallon containers and other wastes are collected in drum liners and shipped back to office for disposal.

Public works notified of abandoned solid waste at site and the possible need for a street sweeper.
