V.	 DISCUSS Agenda Items for December Committee Meeting December meeting will be held on the third Thursday of the month on December 20th, 2018 at 1220 Morello Avenue, Martinez, CA. The December meeting will be focused on compiling the 2018 Annual Report and discussing 2019 goals. Additionally, the MHSA-Finance Committee would like W. Hayes, MHSA Program Manager to discuss the Finance Areas of Interest being considered in the development of the Director's Quarterly Report Dashboard. 	
VI.	 DISCUSS Homeless Awareness Month Crisis D. Dunn (Chair) discussed the Proposition 2-No Place Like Home- proposal drafting process and supplemental documentation that was introduced in the Consolidated Planning Advisory Workgroup (CPAW) Systems of Care Meeting, and that the deadline for submitting proposals for the first round of funding is January 30th, 2019. W. Hayes, MHSA Program Manager, noted that Contra Costa is considered a large county in the competition for these funds under Proposition 2. There are very specific guidelines for completing applications, and requirements that the resulting housing programs will be able to clearly demonstrate community integration. Currently, Behavioral Health Services, H3 (Health, Housing and Homeless Services), and Conservation and Development 	

•	Community Housing Services have been in coordination to find "shovel-ready" projects within the community, as well as outline respective responsibilities in this application process. Each application could result in 20 million in project funding. L. May introduced an agency that she has been in contact with, Swords to Plowshares that are looking to expand their footprint and services in Antioch and may want to be considered for this funding. W. Hayes said that a follow-up on the status of applications may a good agenda item for the January MHSA-Finance Committee or Commission meeting. L. May discussed the ANKA Memorial Service and noted that this would be their last year for this event.
