I-80 E toward Sacramento  
Merge onto CA-242 S toward Oakland/Concord.  
Take the Concord Avenue exit, EXIT 1C  
Turn left onto Concord Avenue  
Stay straight to go onto Galindo Street  
Make a U-turn onto Galindo Street  
Make a U-turn onto Galindo Street  
1350 Galindo Street is on the right

**From East County**

CA-4 W toward Hercules  
Merge onto CA-242 S toward Oakland/Concord.  
Take the Concord Avenue exit, EXIT 1C  
Turn left onto Concord Avenue  
Stay straight to go onto Galindo Street  
Make a U-turn onto Galindo Street  
Make a U-turn onto Galindo Street  
1350 Galindo Street is on the right

**From South County**

I-680 North.  
Take the Monument Boulevard exit, EXIT 49B
