Merge onto CA-4 W via the ramp on the LEFT toward RICHMOND. Take the MORELLO AVENUE exit, EXIT 11
Turn LEFT onto MORELLO AVENUE
1220 MORELLO AVENUE is on the LEFT

From West County

Merge onto I-80 E toward SACRAMENTO
Merge onto CA-4 E toward MARTINEZ/STOCKTON.
Take the MORELLO AVENUE exit toward GLACIER DRIVE
Turn RIGHT onto MORELLO AVENUE
1220 MORELLO AVENUE is on the LEFT

From South County

Merge onto I-680 N via the ramp on the LEFT toward SACRAMENTO Merge onto CA-4 W via EXIT 53 toward MARTINEZ/HERCULES. Take the MORELLO AVENUE exit, EXIT 11
Turn LEFT onto MORELLO AVENUE
