Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) FACT SHEET

Understanding MHSA in Contra Costa County

What is MHSA?

- Proposition 63 (MHSA) passed in November 2004
- 1% tax on personal annual incomes that exceed one million dollars that supports a statewide mental health fund
- Addresses prevention, early intervention, intensive service needs, training, infrastructure and technology
- Expands and transforms California's public behavioral health system to better serve those who are at risk or living with serious mental health issues

Five Components of MHSA

Community Supports and Services (CSS)

- 76% of MHSA budget
- Serves people of all ages who are dealing with a serious mental illness or serious emotional disturbance
- Majority must be spent on full-service partnership (FSP) programs

Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI)

- 19% of MHSA budget
- Majority must serve Youth

Innovation (INN)

- 5% of MHSA budget
- Time limited funding for unique projects and initiatives
- Oversight and approval through the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC)

Workforce Education and Training (WET)

■ To develop and retain a diverse workforce that can appropriately serve the linguistic and cultural needs of the community

Capital Facilities/Technological Needs (CFTN)

Supporting infrastructure projects that enhance service delivery
