What is CalAIM



California Advancing & Innovating Medi-Cal

CalAIM is led by DHCS (Department of Health Care Services) and aims to improve the quality of life and health outcomes of Medi-Cal beneficiaries by taking a person-centered approach that targets social determinants of health and reduces health disparities and inequities.

Who is eligible for CalAIM ECM Services?



- 1. Clients must be enrolled in a Contra Costa Health Plan managed care plan in order to receive the ECM benefit.**

- 2. Populations of Focus**
 - a. Individuals and Families Experiencing Homelessness**
 - b. Adult High Utilizers**
 - c. Adults with Serious Mental Illness / Substance Use Disorder**
 - d. All WPC Members enrolled in a Managed Care Plan will transition to ECM**

CommunityConnect Transition to CalAIM



What will continue?

- In person case management services for those enrolled. continued for those with CCHP managed care plan.
- Focused on social needs
- Coordination of medical and mental health services with providers
- Interdisciplinary team approach

What will no longer be provided?

- Incentives discontinued:
 - Cell phones
 - Bay Area Legal Aid contract
 - Housing Fund
 - Transportation *(transportation for medical appointments will be provided through CCHP transportation)*
