American Standard operated a vitrified porcelain manufacturing facility from 1913 to 1967. The site consisted of a 10.5 acre manufacturing facility (FMF); a 2 acre former waste disposal area and the adjacent banks of Rheem Creek (referred to as the FWDA); and a 34.5 acre adjacent property known as the Lazy J Ranch (LJR). The site was divided into three Operable Units (OU): OU-I = FWDA: OU-II = FMF; and OU-III = LJR. Rheem Creek separates FMF and FWDA; Giant Road separates FWDA and FMF from LJR. Metals were used in the glazing pigmentation process. Wastewater containing glaze and other process wastes were disposed in settling ponds at the FWDA adjacent to FMF.


