Quality Matters!

MAT for Alcohol use Disorder (AUD) and Opioid/Opiate Use Disorders (OUD) on the spotlight! The increase in Fentanyl and Fentanyl use combined with Methamphetamine as well as Alcohol continues to rise. We all know, that those combinations are recipes for disaster. We can help our clients by doing a Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) referral and by providing consistent-ongoing Care Coordination.

When a client enters treatment with an OUD or AUD regardless of the severity level, a referral to MAT is REQUIRED. (Senate Bill 184; Health and Safety Code Sections 11832.9 and 11834.28). Here are a few reminders, and always refer back to your program's MAT policy for additional information.

- Intake Note: Document that a referral to MAT was offered. Record the name and location of the provider.
- (Example: Client referred to X Program) Document if the client accepted or declined the referral. Be sure to include if the client entered treatment with medication. Include the name and dosage. (Example: Client is prescribed 80 mg methadone; client is prescribed 8mg of Suboxone 2x daily; client is receiving monthly Vivitrol injections for AUD)
- Release of Information
- **Problem List:** Include MAT on the list
- Daily Note: Describe any changes/progress. This includes any dosage changes, increases or decreases in cravings or withdrawal symptoms, etc.

Please note that your MAT Policies are being reviewed for DMC-ODS audits. The policy must include all of the required elements. If you need assistance, please contact the QI team @ AODS administration. We are here to help!

The Department of Health Care Services will be conducting an Annual/Triennial "Combo" Audit of the Behavioral Health Plan from September 12 through September 22, 2023 to include: the Mental Health Plan, SABG and DMC-ODS Plan. This is an extensive audit that will require 100% staff attention and focus. We thank you all for helping us gather the "evidence of practice" documents that were submitted as part of the initial required submission which was due on August 21st. We also thank you in advance for your understanding in case our availability of time is limited during that period of time in September. Contra Costa is one of five counties that will be undergoing this type of integrated audit this year.

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) launched the new primary prevention data system. ECCO went Live on July 1, 2023! ECCO is the online platform that will now collect all CalOMSpv data, services for billing and outcome data. ECCO Trainings for county and prevention providers staff are underway through the end of August 2023. Jessica Recinos, our fabulous County Prevention Coordinator is providing technical assistant to primary prevention providers.
