
# INITIAL PARAMEDIC ACCREDITATION PROCESS FLOW

### Paramedic Accreditation Approval

Once you receive approval from CCCEMSA you may now practice as an Accredited Paramedic in Contra Costa County.

Successfully complete the CCCEMSA EMSO within sixty (60) days prior to applying for Accreditation.

CCCEMSA Orientation (EMSO) Once you receive approval from CCCEMSA you may now practice as a paramedic in your Supervised Field Evaluation.
