QUALITY MATTERS CORNER!

Most Common Documentation Deficiencies in FY21–22 and FY22–23:

- Missing intake notes. Some of the intake notes do not include all the required elements
- Late progress notes
- · ROI's are not being filled out correctly or missing
- Missing physical exams signed by the Medical Director in the file. No documentation on the Problem List/Care Plan that attempts are being made to complete the physical examination or obtain a TB test (residential)
- Curriculum used and the topic of the group are not being documented in the group note
- Missing LPHA face to face Medical Necessity note
- Outdated Forms: Some programs are still using the old Consent to Treat and Discharge Plan/Summary and other documents and uploading them into SmartCare instead of using the forms in the system.
- Discharge date is the date of the final service not the date when the paperwork is filled out.
- Progress notes do not adhere to the Certification Standards Section 8000.

- 2. AODS will generate the SmartCare Billing Report on the 11th or next business day of the month and the reports will be distributed to Providers via e-mail. You will use this report to generate your invoice or D15.
