What is a Compact Mobile Food Operation (CMFO)?

A CMFO is a new type of mobile food facility that is **unenclosed**, **nonmotorized**, and sells **whole produce**, **prepackaged food**, and/or conducts **limited food preparation**.



Easier to Get a Health Permit

As of January 1, 2023, the law was updated to make it easier to obtain a health permit for sidewalk food vendors and first-time entrepreneurs. **Certain operations may even be exempt.** Becoming a permitted food vendor shows the community that the food you sell is less likely to make people sick.
