

2024 COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS WORKPLAN

- 1. Work towards the countywide goal of reducing unsheltered homelessness by 75% by 2024 through the work of the PATH Innovations Committee.
- 2. Continue to provide advice and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors about issues relating to homelessness
- 3. Convene stakeholders, in partnership with H3, to create a regional action plan as part of the application to the State's HHAP program
- 4. Update and redesign the CoC's Coordinated Entry prioritization and assessment tools to create a more equitable process
- Continue to seek opportunities for individuals with lived experience of homelessness to engage in policy-making and planning conversations, especially as relates to assessment and prioritization within the Coordinated Entry System
- 6. Implement changes to the CoC NOFO scoring tools to better prioritize resources during the annual funding competition
