

HOW TO GET TEST RESULTS

By Phone or Online



Advice Nurse Line 1-877-661-6230 (press 1)

Our advice nurses answer calls 24/7, but some times are busier than others. For *routine* lab results for tests done at a county health center, leave a message for the advice nurse, including your full name (with the spelling), medical record number and telephone number, as well as the best time to call you back. A nurse will return your call within 24 hours. The advice nurse can give you the results for the following tests:

- Complete blood count
- Lead
- Cholesterol and blood sugar
- Liver panel, hepatitis and most other blood tests
- X-rays
- Pap smear and mammogram results (4 weeks after your test)

For HIV test results, you must make an appointment with your primary care doctor.
