  - ✓ Training provides a copy and explanation of any local body art bloodborne pathogen ordinances.
  - ✓ Training covers transmission, control and symptoms of bloodborne pathogen diseases.
  - ✓ Covers how specific tasks in body art practice can lead to exposure.
  - ✓ Covers personal protective equipment (PPE) use and limitations.
  - ✓ Covers task type, technique, and when to put on PPE in the process.
  - ✓ Covers hand hygiene with demonstrations.
  - ✓ Covers types, use and storage of disinfectants and antiseptics.
  - ✓ Covers signage and labeling required for biohazardous materials, chemicals and supplies.
  - ✓ Covers Hepatitis B vaccination information.
  - ✓ Covers what is an exposure incident including:
    - Examples of exposures, how the exposures occurred, and actions to prevent future exposures.
    - Risk of infection following an exposure.
    - Post-exposure procedures, including medical follow-up.
