

## HOUSING INFORMATION FOR LANDLORDS & PROPERTY MANAGERS

Do you live in a home in Unincorporated Contra Costa County that has 2 or more units attached? Then you and your family have a *RIGHT* to live in an environment, safe from secondhand smoke.

Smoking or vaping any tobacco or cannabis is prohibited in any multi-unit housing complex with 2 or more attached units within unincorporated county. (Ordinance 2-18-07)

## This means that no one is allowed to smoke:



1) Inside their unit



2) On ANY balconies, patios, porches & decks



3) In ANY Indoor common areas\*



4) In ANY Outdoor common areas\*

Any violators of the law will be fined and cited with fines up to \$1,000.

## Protect yourself, your family and your community.

If you smoke, by law you must be 25 feet outside of the property boundaries. Any violators will be cited.
