## **Public Health Advisory**

Contra Costa Health (CCH) today reaffirms its commitment to reproductive health rights, and to ensure that all county residents may access safe, legal, nonjudgmental care, including abortion services.

The U.S. Supreme Court's decision to overturn its *Roe v. Wade* decision have understandably raised fears in the community about the future of reproductive health rights and bodily autonomy. The ability to access reproductive healthcare – and to maintain autonomy over our own bodies – is essential to the health and wellbeing of everyone in our community.

Any loss of reproductive rights threatens us all, particularly women, and especially those living in communities of color and others disproportionately affected by health inequities. Less access to care in Contra Costa County would only deepen those inequities.

That is why CCH stands with our community's providers and women in supporting continued, unfettered access to all reproductive and sexual healthcare services, including access to abortion services for pregnant people who choose to end an unwanted pregnancy.

While we are encouraged that California lawmakers have indicated they will not allow that decision to limit abortion services in our state and may change the state constitution to strengthen legal protections of our reproductive rights, the recent ruling may confuse some people about the legality or propriety of accessing abortion services.

CCH urges all community health providers to:

- Provide confidential, nonjudgmental assistance to all women seeking abortion services to understand and navigate their options
- Ensure the provision of current, accurate health information regarding abortion services
- Familiarize themselves with community reproductive healthcare resources so they can better assist women who choose to access them
